DDLETB had circa €14.1m on hand at the end of January. The report reflects three discrete deficits, two of which (Main Scheme – Pay and Non Main Scheme) are not substantive in nature. The first is due to a timing difference in the receipt of funding, the second is awaiting the outcome of the SOLAS budget approval process, which will see the redirection of receipts under Training Centres to Non Main Scheme, thereby addressing the deficit. The deficit on the Main Scheme - Non-Pay has accumulated

over a number of years and currently DES appear to have no plan in place to address this issue.

The Main Scheme Non-Pay spending limit was confirmed by DES at €8,164,687 for 2018. This represents a marginal increase on 2017 and is less than will be required. Insurance costs, contracted cleaning and the costs arising from the addition of new extra students and extra school facilities mean that DDLETB will incur a deficit of circa €250k for 2018. This matter will be raised with DES in the short term.
