DDLETB had approximately €26.3m on hand at the end of September 2019. The Main Scheme Pay deficit relates to a timing difference between when payments issued to staff and the receipt of the monies from DES.

The deficit on the Main Scheme Non-Pay has accumulated over a number of years and will require an injection of cash to resolve. A figure of €238,000.00 was reduced by DES from the September's non-pay payment to DDLETB as DDL had been carrying a surplus in respect of PLC and Higher Education grants, which are no longer issued by DDL

The Main Scheme Non-Pay spending limit for 2019 is €8,388,292. This represents an increase of 2.7% on 2018. Insurance costs, contracted cleaning and the costs arising from the additional of new students and extra school facilities means that DDLETB will incur a deficit of circa €250K in 2019. This matter has been raised with DES.

<p>4) CEOs Report</p> <p>1. Danú Community Special School (Danú CSS) opened in Hansfield Educate Together Secondary School (ETSS). Many thanks to all in ETSS who have made Danú CSS welcome. Students are being prepared for the transition by teachers and SNAs who have undergone training with the NCSE. The training was very well received thanks to the professionalism of the facilitators.</p>		

2. **Rivervalley CNS** has its cohort of 4 year olds in school on site behind the Riasc centre in Swords. The original plan for temporary accommodation in the McGrane's Yard is to be completed before Christmas.

3. **Broadmeadow CNS** did not open for students as planned in September. We expect to appoint a new Principal before Christmas to take up duty in February. There was a demand for places and the original Principal Michael Byrne has taken over as Principal in Citywest and Saggart CNS. He is keeping the profile of Broadmeadow CNS alive. The temporary accommodation on the Swords CC site is ready for occupation.

4. **FET** - we are on track in relation to the spending targets for the 60 million budget. The targets for the activity as agreed with Solas are being met. A review will take place between DDL and Solas on 5th November with external evaluators from Northern Ireland and the UK.

5. **The Teacher Leadership Programme** was initiated for two sessions in September and October. Over 120 teachers took part which is the best attendance at a voluntary programme in this ETB ever. The participants were fully engaged in the programme and are working on projects which are about collaborating to respond to a challenge they have identified in the school. Many thanks to Adrian Flynn and especially Caroline Daly for making it so successful.

6. **The FÍS programme** has begun in earnest this term. It is supporting schools as they prepare for inspections like the MLL, DEIS, SEN. Thanks to Rosemarie McGill and Adrian Flynn for their work with schools. The Principals are happy with the support and see how it is helping to ensure previous recommendations are addressed appropriately.

7. **Coláiste Pobail Setanta** held celebrations for its 10th anniversary. The President Michael D. Higgins attended and spoke passionately about the school and its effect on the community. In particular he paid tribute to the staff for ensuring students had an equal opportunity in Irish society as a result of the excellent standards in the school.

8. **Jigsaw** launched a collaboration with the JCSP Libraries initiative on Riversdale CC. The CEO of Jigsaw saw great benefit in students being given opportunities to read books that supported the development of their coping

	<p>skills. Jigsaw provided the library and other JCSP libraries with over 100 books dealing with mental health as well as making the digital books available online in the county libraries.</p> <p>9. The patronage campaign concluded on the 4th October. We applied for patronage for post-primary schools in Blanchardstown, Citywest and Saggart, and Goatstown-Stillorgan. We expect the result in a couple of weeks. A Primary school campaign is due to begin before Christmas.</p> <p>10. Buildings - The remedial works on a number of our buildings as a result of the DES survey of WBS buildings has begun. Protective scaffolding will remain in place for some time yet at Lucan CNS, Scoil Aoife CNS, Scoil Choilm CNS and Castlemill AES. Work on Ardgillan CC is being put into a remediation programme which will extend for a couple of years. In the meantime provision for temporary accommodation is to be made.</p> <p>11. Board of Management Induction will be provided for new Boards of Management as soon as the trainers have attended the relevant sessions in ETBI. Training for the Chairperson of each board of the ETB will be provided before Christmas and training for board members will happen after Christmas.</p> <p>12. Scoil Choilm CNS had its WSE and had a remarkably good report. Congratulations to Treasa Lowe and her staff who achieved so many excellent comments from the inspectors in relation to the quality of teaching and learning and the quality of leadership.</p> <p>13. Induction Programmes for New Principals, Deputies and new teachers have taken place here in Head Office. CPD for Principals and Deputies also took place. Thanks to all who helped prepare the sessions and those who facilitated the evenings.</p>
