What is the National FET Learner Forum?

The National Further Education and Training (FET) Learner Forum is designed to provide a platform for you to share your experience in FET. You share your experience by:

- Participating in focus group discussion (1 hour)
- Completing a survey (15 minutes)
- Participating in an optional mental health focus group discussion (1 hour)

During the focus group, the facilitators will ask questions to encourage discussions and share ideas, so we can help improve the FET service. It's really important to note that there are no right or wrong answers. We want to hear about your own experiences with the FET service and get your honest feedback.

- Teaching and learning resources
- Facilities
- Services and supports

After lunch, you will have the option to hear a presentation on mental health by Jigsaw, the National Centre for Youth Mental Health, and take part in a discussion on mental health.

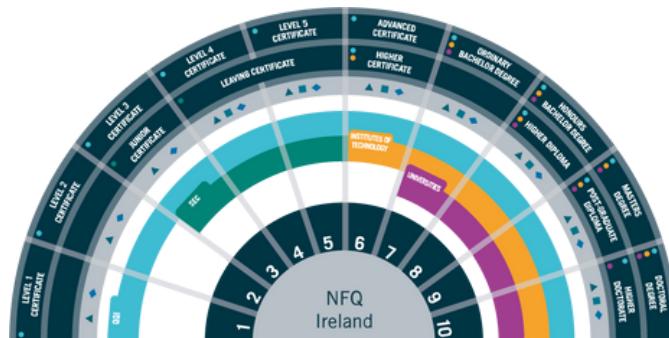

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Registration:

For registration you will be asked to confirm the level of the course you are taking. This refers to the level of your course on the National Frameworks of Qualifications (NFQ). You can find an image of this framework below. If you are unsure of what level you are on, you can ask your tutor in advance of the meeting and they can tell you prior to your arrival.



Consent:

You will be asked to complete a consent form on the day of the event. This consent form has been provided along with this information sheet. Please take the time to read this over in advance of the meeting. On the day, you will be asked to sign this consent form. If you have any questions on this, please feel free to email us.

Questions:

Do I have to participate?

No. Your participation is voluntary

Are my opinions anonymous?

Yes. All information collected will be anonymised before reporting. All personal details will be kept by AONTAS for one year and will then be destroyed. It will not be shared with any outside bodies.

Are the groups recorded?

Yes. They will be audio recorded for reporting purposes.

Will photos be taken?

Yes. You will sign a consent form for photos. If you do not want your photo taken, you can opt out. Just let a member of staff know.

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Travel Reimbursement:

Each learner is eligible for reimbursement to cover the estimated expense of travelling to and from the event. This reimbursement will be given in the form of a 'One4all' or 'Me2You' voucher and will be given at the event.

Distance Travelled		Voucher Amount
0-120km Roundtrip	=	€20
+120km Roundtrip	=	€50

Please note the following:

- Each nominated learner is reimbursed with a voucher. The amount it is worth is based on the distance you travelled to and from the event
- The above reimbursement will be paid on the day of the event once the learner provides receipts
- Pictures of receipts/tickets can be taken if the learner requires it for further use (ie return tickets)
- Learners who have a bus or taxi booked will not be entitled to the reimbursement
- In cases where learners travel together, the driver will receive the reimbursement
- These reimbursements cover travel only. No subsistence or accommodation is covered
