FET Response to Ukrainian Refugee Crisis

As the main reception centres for refugees are in Citywest and the Red Cow Hotel which are both located in the South Dublin County area while Fingal particularly the Swords area is also welcoming large numbers of refugees.

4,414 beneficiaries in ESOL FET in 2022. This is 1,783 higher than projected in January 2022 and is mainly due to the crisis in Ukraine. 77% are female and the age range is 18 to 83 years old.
