# 5. Matters Submitted by the Executive

#### July Provision

Community National Schools ran July Provision during the month of July, with schools providing for home tuition if a teacher couldn't be recruited for the school.

Two DEIS schools ran the Literacy Camp for the month of July, providing tuition for targeted groups of children requiring additional support, including the new Ukrainian students in these schools.

Detention and High Support Centres provided for summer programmes, running the  $2^{nd}$  week of August.

DEIS (Delivering Equality of Opportunity in Schools) Action planning and Grant Allocation for all DEIS schools, Circular 34/2023 came into effect 10<sup>th</sup> July, 2023. It outlines for management authorities and Boards of Management the:

- requirements for schools participating in the DEIS Programme to engage in systematic planning for improvement.
- Requirement for the DEIS grant to be used to support those children and young people most at risk of disadvantage.
- The management and oversight of the DEIS grant.

Publication of Child Protection procedures for Primary and Post Primary Schools (revised 2023) was published 28<sup>th</sup> August. Directors of Schools have worked with their respective schools to ensure that all schools have updated child safeguarding and Risk assessment which is to be brought to the school's first Board of Management meeting this year.

New Primary Mathematics Curriculum for Primary and Special schools was launched on 7<sup>th</sup> September. It will be delivered in three phases, Introduction (2023-24) Implementation (2024-25) and Embedding (2025-beyond).

Directors of Schools continues to engage with Principals in supporting through regular meetings, individual school visits in addition to providing training at ETBI level for the Community National Schools.

Conchubhair Mac Ghloinn gave a presentation to the Board members on the professional development day that took place on the 26<sup>th</sup> August for all 4 Gaelcholáistí and thanked DDLETB Senior Leadership Team for their support.

A member asked if we could provide a list of teaching posts that we have filled this year and any that are still waiting to be filled in all our schools.

New Youth Development officer, Claire Barkey, and team of Youth Officers continue to engage with all Youth Service Provision in implementation of provision under UBU with a focus on ALP expansion for this academic year.

#### College Of Further Education and Training DDLETB

Briefing and consultations continued as planned in September 2023 and more briefings will be scheduled later in the year and early next year.

• In the meantime, a detailed Preliminary Business Case has been sent to SOLAS. SOLAS have secured centralised QS expertise to support ETBs with their estimated costs. SOLAS now need to provide centralised support so that an independent Multi Criteria Analysis is carried out on the proposals.

Strategic Infrastructure upgrade- Monastery Road, Clondalkin Village

This is a tight, town centre site so a brief development report has been prepared to
ensure the new build produces the maximum capacity possible the budget allocated
to DDLETB.

### Update on FET funding

- We were hopeful in June 2023 that SOLAS would sanction funding to cover the potential shortfall between our initial funding bid of €83 million and our final allocation of €80 million so that provision will not need to be scaled back.
- Formally SOLAS are saying that they do not want provision scaled back but that DDLETB does need to work within their original allocation i.e., €80 million for DDLETB FET for 2023.
- However, SOLAS will seek an expenditure report up to the end of September so that
  they can better project the full year expenditure for every ETB. DDLETB will make the
  case for additional funding if required based on the significant population growth
  across the three administrative regions we serve and for the significant increase in
  demand for ESOL across this region, which we must continue to meet.

## <u>Apprenticeship</u>

DDLETB and ETBs around the country have been working hard to implement emergency measures required to reduce the backlog created by COVID 19, for Apprenticeship Phase 2 for the 3 main craft areas electrical, plumbing and carpentry and joinery. This involved adding new electrical workshops to both Baldoyle TC earlier this year and Tallaght TC which are due to open this autumn. DDLETB has submitted proposals for a major capital investment in Loughlinstown TC, which will increase capacity significantly there also.

While the backlog due to COVID 19 has been addressed, the buoyant economy since the pandemic has led to a corresponding increase in the number of new apprentices seeking to participate in apprenticeships.

DDLETB reported to SOLAS in late 2022 and again in 2023, that capital investment on its own was not going to be sufficient to address the increasing waiting list. In the Dublin area, it has been very challenging to recruit Instructors to deliver apprenticeships due to competition from industry for qualified, experienced electricians who can offer better terms and conditions than DDLETB can to potential instructors. Other ETBs are experiencing the same issues with recruitment, and this has reduced the speed at which the waiting list can be reduced.

The Minister is concerned about this and has asked the FET sector to work together to deliver as much as possible and to work with Higher Education institutions if they have additional capacity/workshops around the country.

### Director of OSD Update to the Board – September 2023

I am delighted to have joined DDLETB and I look forward to working with the team and stakeholders to deliver our strategic initiatives over the coming years. Since starting in my role in late June, I have focused on gaining an understanding of the culture and the day to day running of DDLETB, through attending stakeholder and staff meetings, visiting schools and FET centres along with my attendance at various ETBI events. My initial focus will be on supporting the priority areas of building, finance and cybersecurity while also leading on the delivery of the new DDLETB strategy.

Please note that following on from the updates in relation to a new lease for DDLETB Head Office that were given during the June 2022 and February 2023 Board meetings, we now are at the stage of signing a new 10-year lease for all 5 floors in 1 Tuansgate. DDLETB previously held leases for the 1<sup>st</sup>,2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> floors. This new lease will consolidate the existing leases into one single lease while also taking in charge the 5<sup>th</sup> floor. The annual value of the lease will be €645,728. A rent review will take place after 5 years with no break clause in place. We have procured assistance from legal and property advisors to ensure value for money and have received approval from the DoE to proceed. Caitriona Murphy and Paul Turner now request approval from the Board to proceed with the signature of the new 10-year lease and the surrender of the existing leases.
